Answer :: SharePoint (MOSS 2007) is built on top of WSS 3.0, which is built on top of ASP.NET, so you can use any/all of ASP.NET development.with or without MOSS 2007 or WSS 3.0.

There is an internal setting in IIS and/or SharePoint Administration to configure your server to serve Sharepoint content in addition to custom ASP.NET pages. [Read More](#)

Answer :: Sharepoint Designer is for designing/customizing Sharepoint Portals/WSS (Windows Sharepoint Service) 3.0 +. Sharepoint is Microsoft's intranet/collaboration system and has grown significantly in terms of number of installations in the past 2-3 years. IT used to be that FrontPage designer was used to interact with WSS 2.0/Sharepoint. You can use Sharepoint Designer for regular web design, though it's probably not the best choice.

Microsoft Expression Web is part of a new product line that incorporates more "creative" elements than older, more appropriate for "corporate" products. This line is targeted directly at Adobe. Expression Web is designed to compete with Dreamweaver. One of the biggest complaints about the old FrontPage editor was that it lacked flexibility. While FrontPage 2003 was a significant improvement over previous versions, it had a bad reputation among the professional web designers. Microsoft wants to start anew with Expression Web, and to court more professional web designers to use its products. [Read More](#)

Answer :: You can use Microsoft Sharepoint designer 2007 to design your html if you really want to, however, SPD was developed to mostly work with SharePoint Sites. In order to use it for that, you will have to have SharePoint running on your computer, or a remote server that you have access to.

If you need to use a site editor, Microsoft Expression Web or Dreamweaver may be more suitable for you.

Or you could learn HTML and CSS and code pages by hand like I do which might sound harder than it is.
