Answer :: I do IT at an AE firm, and we decided not to use Sharepoint. To be honest though, it was because we have a directory structure for projects in place, and didn't see any benefit to switching to Sharepoint.

We have a batch file that will create a new project directory, with all the folders setup in our standard directory structure. We found it more difficult to set that up in Sharepoint.

Beyond that, we encourage our users to actually open up AutoCAD, and then browse to the file they want to open from within the program. We currently have AutoCAD 2006 and 2007 installed on our users computers. Which version they use depends on what the client wants. If they just navigate to a file, and double-click it, it'll usually open the file in 2007.

We've had trouble with users opening 2006 files in 2007, making changes, and then saving them. 2007 is not very backwards compatible, and it makes opening them in 2006 a lot of grief. So the idea of having our users open files from within Sharepoint isn't very attractive to us.
