Answer :: I am sending a custom master page(Test.master) and content page(default.aspx). You just open the sharepoint designer and add the master page to this location (<a href="http://testsite/testdorlog/\_catalogs/masterpage/Test.master">http://testsite/testdorlog/\_catalogs/masterpage/Test.master</a> and add the content page to the root site. Finally just varify the master page url in default.aspx page.
