

Windows Sharepoint Services 3.0 Questions

I'm writing web parts for sharepoint services 3.0 (NOT 2.0 and NOT office 2007 sharepoint server either). Our company is writing data driven webparts to be used in our sharepoint site, however... any web part i've tried to install isn't working (they work fine in asp.net 2.0 so i am suspecting my dwp and manifest files aren't correctly working. I have a DLL and a .config file...

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I keep getting the error that "webpart does not inherit from Microsoft.Sharepoint.Controls.Webpart and could not be loaded" but according to the WSS 3.0 documentation asp.net 2.0 webparts CAN and SHOULD be completely compatible with wss3.0.

Answer :: Actually i figured it out, when you package a webpart in a .cab file you don't need the DWP you just need a manifest file.

You will need some server-side coding to do that. Someone with Developer rights to your SP environment and can develop in ASP .NET can help you, or you can use one of the free online services.

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-- Do a search for "HTML hit counter"

-- sign up for one of the services

-- Open the page you want counted in SharePoint Designer

-- Add the HTML/Javascript code to the page you want
